### Special Session Minutes

#### 1. Call to Order

Mayor Pro Tem Atkins called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m. and noted for the record that Councilmembers Washington, Kruse (Zoom), and Freeman were present. Also present were City Manager Summer Spurlock, City Attorney Daniel Ray, and City Secretary Carole Kuykendall. Mayor Ransom and Councilmembers Thomas and Collins were absent.

#### 2. Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Pro Tem Atkins led the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### 3. Ordinances

- A. Consideration and action on an emergency ordinance authorizing Weisinger Incorporated to provide and install two (2) rebuilt raw water vertical turbine pumps to include mechanical, electrical and control equipment for the Lake Tawakoni raw water line pumps No. 1 and No. 3 for a fixed price of \$209,620.00 (*Press Tompkins, Public Works Director*)

Public works Director Press Tompkins stated the increase in posted price is for the product to be expediated.

Councilmember Washington moved, Councilmember Freeman seconded for the enactment of Ordinance 21-073: **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, TEXAS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND MAKING IT ESSENTIAL AND NECESSARY TO FOREGO THE BIDDING PROCESS IN ORDER TO AUTHORIZE WEISINGER INCORPORATED TO PROVIDE AND INSTALL TWO (2) REBUILT RAW WATER VERTICAL TURBINE PUMPS TO INCLUDE MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL AND CONTROL EQUIPMENT FOR THE LAKE TAWAKONI RAW WATER LINE PUMPS NO. 1 AND NO. 3, FOR A FIXED PRICE OF \$227,921.00; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** Motion carried by unanimous vote of the City Council present.
