

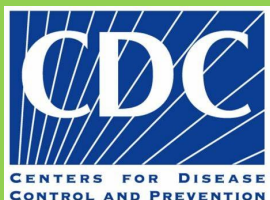

## CONTINUED CLOSURES OF CITY FACILITIES

Closures have been extended until **April 14** (this date may change as conditions change) to include the following:

- **Airport:** Terminal is open. There will be no group meetings or room rentals.
- **Annex (Community Development and Public Works):** Closed to the public. A sign is posted listing multiple department/staff phone numbers, which the public may call to schedule an appointment.
- **Animal Shelter:** Closed to the public. Staff continues to pick up animals; however, there will be no acceptance of animals from the public or owner surrenders. Owner reclaims will be set up by appointment only, Monday-Friday.
- **Civic Center:** Closed to the public. There will be no group meetings or room rentals.
- **Greenville Municipal Auditorium:** Closed to the public. All events are postponed.
- **Library:** Closed to the public. Assistance is being offered by phone and email during normal operating hours. Digital resources and children's programming are provided through social media and website.
- **Municipal Building:** Closed to the public. A sign is posted listing multiple department/staff phone numbers, which the public may call to schedule an appointment.
- **Parks and Recreation:** All park amenities and Reecy Davis Recreation Center are closed to the public. All scheduled programs, activities, and events are cancelled. Open space parks and trails are open and operating according to the National Parks and Recreation Operational Guidelines for COVID-19, which can be viewed by clicking [here](#).
- **Police and Courts:** Municipal court is closed to the public.
- **Fire Administration:** Closed to the public. A sign is posted listing staff phone numbers, which the public may call to schedule an appointment.

\* These closures will be re-evaluated on a weekly basis, as we know changes in COVID-19 are rapid.

**GREENVILLE FIRE-RESCUE (GFR):** In the next few days, GFR will be releasing a free COVID-19 community self-reporting tool provided by First Due. First Due is providing a focused version of their Community Connect platform, in order to help Fire-EMS, Police, Emergency Management, and Healthcare agencies better combat the COVID-19 pandemic.

Community Connect bridges the data and communication gap between Public Safety agencies and the communities they serve by allowing residents to create online household life safety profiles made available to First Responders at the time of dispatch. Now, First Due is deploying Community Connect for COVID-19. "This tool will allow fire and EMS agencies the ability to know better where citizens have self-isolated or self-quarantined themselves in their community. With this information at their fingertips, firefighters and EMS personnel will have a much clearer picture about who they are responding to and what their health situation is."

This information can also be shared with our local EMS and police departments to help protect our first responders even further. All self-reporting is strictly voluntary and does not require residents to have had a COVID-19 test but will be able to alert first responders to potential exposure prior to their arrival. This in turn may help reduce the need for first responders to be removed from duty to be quarantined, due to unknown/inadvertent exposures.
