## **Agenda**

### **1. Call to Order**

Mayor Reid called the Special Meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. Present were Councilmembers Perkins, Perks, Dailey, Del Bosque-Hobdy, Francey and Linson-Bell. Also present were City Manager Steve Alexander, City Secretary Debra Newell and City Attorney Brent Money.

### **2. Invocation**

Mayor Reid gave the invocation.

### **3. Executive Session**

The Mayor announced the time as 5:16 p.m. and stated the Council would now go into Executive Session under Section 551.071 (1) - L-3 Communications vs. City of Greenville Lawsuit and Settlement.

### **4. Take any action as needed from Executive Session**

Upon reconvening in Open Session at 5:59 p.m., the Mayor said he would entertain a motion to approve Robert Scott as Attorney of Record in all matters pertaining to L-3 vs. the City of Greenville.

Councilmember Perkins noted for the record that he has the utmost respect for Bob Scott, but he thinks the Council is better served by Mike Moran who has been working on this lawsuit for the past two years. Councilmember Francey noted that Mike Moran's hourly fee is quite high. Councilmember Del Bosque-Hobdy noted that Mr. Moran is already up to speed on the aspects of this lawsuit. Councilmember Dailey said he believes Bob Scott is in the best position to assist the City in this regard.

Councilmember Dailey moved to approve Bob Scott as Attorney of Record in all L-3 matters, Councilmember Francey seconded. Motion carried by majority (5-2) consent of the City Council. Councilmembers Perkins and Del Bosque-Hobdy voted "no".
