**1. Call to Order**

Mayor Reid called the Special City Council meeting to order at 5:07 p.m. Present were Councilmembers Perkins, Evans, Del Bosque-Hobdy, Francey and Linson-Bell. Also present were City Secretary Debra Newell and City Attorney Daniel Ray. Councilmember Dailey was absent.

The Council did not convene in Executive Session.

**3. Consideration and action on an ordinance appointing an Interim City Manager (*City Council*)**

Mayor Reid said he would like to suggest Massoud Ebrahim to be the Interim City Manager, due to his length of service with the City.

Councilmember Perkins suggested Police Chief Dan Busken, due to his ability to interact with the public and he has a Masters of Public Administration. He also suggested as an alternative, to hire a company that contracts out interim city managers.

Councilmember Del Bosque-Hobdy suggested Barry Robinson. He said he must decline at this time.

Councilmember Francey moved to name Massoud Ebrahim as the Interim City Manager, Councilmember Bell seconded for the enactment of Ordinance No. 13-038: **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, TEXAS, NAMING AN INTERIM CITY MANAGER FOR THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, TEXAS, AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FULL FORCE ON MAY 20, 2013 AT 5:00 P.M.** Motion carried by majority (4-2) consent of the City Council with Councilmembers Perkins and Del Bosque-Hobdy voting "no."

**4. Discuss and possibly take action on Parks and Recreation Department Reorganization and Police Department Reorganization (*City Council*)**

Item 4 was discussed prior to item 3. Mayor Reid asked Colby VanGundy to explain the reorganization time frame and process. Colby VanGundy explained that when the Assistant City Manager left, the Venue Manager was placed under his supervision. This change and possible increased compensation had been discussed for sometime with the former City Manager.

Police Chief Dan Busken noted his situation is a bit different, as moving Animal Control under the Police Department has not taken place. He and the former City Manager discussed the move at length. Additional compensation was also discussed, due to the increased employees and responsibilities. He would not be opposed to waiting for the interim or new city manager to make the final decision.

Councilmember Perkins made a motion to increase Colby VanGundy's salary by 5%. Councilmember Francey noted that all departments should be checked for additional duties that have been added and then a decision should be made.

Not action was taken on this item.
