- A. Consideration and action on an ordinance authorizing the approval of Hotel Occupancy Tax Funding for FY 2016-2017 (*Doyle Dick, Main Street Manager*)

Councilmember Dean moved, Councilmember Money seconded for the enactment of Ordinance 16-054: **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF TOURISM AND CONVENTION ADVISORY BOARD FUNDING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** Motion carried by unanimous vote of the City Council.

- B. Consideration and action on an ordinance rescinding Ordinance 16-050 which approved the installation of fluoridation equipment with the subsequent ongoing fluoridation of City drinking water (*John Wright, Public Works Director*)

Councilmember Evans moved to rescind Ordinance 16-050, Councilmember Dean seconded for the enactment of Ordinance 16-055: **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, TEXAS, RESCINDING ORDINANCE 16-050 WHICH APPROVED THE INSTALLATION OF FLUORIDATION EQUIPMENT WITH THE SUBSEQUENT ONGOING FLUORIDATION OF CITY DRINKING WATER; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** Motion failed to rescind Ordinance 16-050 by 3-4 vote with Councilmembers Evans, Dailey, and Dean voting "for" and Mayor Dreiling and Councilmembers Ransom, Gotcher, and Money voting "against."




