**1. Call to Order**

**3. Executive Session**



Upon reconvening into Open Session at 8:29 p.m., Councilmember Turner moved, Councilmember Dean seconded for the enactment of Ordinance 18-014: **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, TEXAS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND MAKING IT ESSENTIAL AND NECESSARY FOREGO THE BIDDING PROCESS IN RELATION TO WORK DONE ON WESLEY STREET FOR THE COLLAPSED SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM FOR THE RETENTION OF NECESSARY CONSULTANTS AND CONTRACTORS TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** Motion carried by unanimous vote of the City Council.
