Regular Session Meeting

1. Call to Order

Mayor Dreiling called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. and noted for the record that Mayor Pro Tem Ransom and Councilmembers Atkins, Turner, Gotcher, Money, and Dean were present through videoconferencing. Also present were City Manager Summer Spurlock, City Attorney Daniel Ray, and City Secretary Carole Kuykendall.

2. Invocation

Councilmember Money gave the invocation.

3. Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Dreiling led the Pledge of Allegiance.

4. Citizens to be Heard

Councilmember Ransom read a statement from Avery Davidson who was not going to be able to call during Citizens to be Heard. A call was made to Alexandria Vaughn but there was no answer.

5. Ordinances

- A. Consideration and action on an ordinance regarding an advisory from Governor Greg Abbott authorizing all political subdivisions holding general or special elections on May 2, 2020 to postpone their election to the November 3, 2020 uniform election date. *(Daniel W. Ray, City Attorney)*

Councilmember Turner moved to move the Election to November 3, 2020, Mayor Dreiling seconded. Motion failed by 3-3-1 vote with Mayor Dreiling and Councilmember Turner and Gotcher voting "for" and Councilmember Atkins, Money, and Dean voting "against." Mayor Pro Tem Ransom abstained.

6. Resolutions

- A. Consideration and action on a resolution implementing appropriate measures to contain and prevent the spread of COVID-19 for the health, safety, and welfare of the community and its citizens *(City Council)*

Mayor Pro Tem moved to allow the City Manager to implement appropriate measures, Councilmember Turner seconded for the enactment of Resolution 20-27: **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, TEXAS, CONTINUING APPROPRIATE MEASURES TO CONTAIN AND PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 FOR THE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE OF THE COMMUNITY**

AND ITS CITIZENS (FIRST REVISION); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the City Council.


9. Take action on any item discussed in Executive Session
