### Special Session Minutes

#### 1. Call to Order

Mayor Dreiling called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. and noted for the record that Councilmember Atkins, Money, and Dean were in attendance; in attendance via Zoom were Mayor Pro Tem Ransom and Councilmember Turner. Mayor Pro Tem Ransom moved, Councilmember Turner seconded for the enactment of Ordinance 20-053: **AN AMENDED AND RESTATED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, TEXAS, CALLING A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2020, A UNIFORM ELECTION DATE, WITHIN SAID CITY; MAKING PROVISION FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION AND OTHER PROVISIONS INCIDENTAL THERETO.** Motion carried by majority 5-1 vote of Councilmembers present with Mayor Dreiling, Mayor Pro Tem Ransom, and Councilmembers Atkins, Turner, and Money voting "for" and Councilmember Dean voting "against".
