PUBLIC WORKS: Engineering: Sayle Street: The contractor started the lime subgrade procedures from Kari to Lark and will be remixing the subgrade late this week; concrete placement will start approximately September 8; residents have been placed on the new utility mains within this area; crews are still replacing water and sewer lines on Sayle from Maple to Webb. **Cedar Addition:** Crews removed curb and gutter and will be placing concrete next week, with the anticipation of milling operations starting September 13. **Industrial Drive:** Crews laid the last section of pavement this week to complete this project.

Streets: This week, crews continued mowing the long branch channel with the anticipation of completion by the end of the week; started mowing the town branch channel behind the Hunt County Sheriff's office; and patched potholes in the Washington Heights area.



Traffic: Crews cleared limbs from falling trees; replaced faded stop signs (Pic. 1) in several areas of the city; and placed and secured benches downtown for pedestrians. (Pic. 2)

Water Distribution: Crews repaired a broken water valve on O'Neal at Wesley; and made several minor repairs in the Jones Street area.



Wastewater Collections: Crews continued cleaning sewer lines within the city and replaced several sections of sewer mains in the Caddo Street area.
