## Public Works

**Wastewater Collections Division:** Crews were able to replace roughly 60' of sewer main in the 3300 Block of King with new services.

### Engineering Division:

**Stanford Street** - The contractor has continued to place sanitary sewer and storm pipe from Sayle to Roberts.

**Sayle Street** - The contractor has opened the northbound lane to Canton Street and is currently excavating the south lane.

**Roy Warren Parkway** - The contractor has continued to place concrete on the east lane; 75% of this lane has been placed.

**Delano Estates** - The contractor has started the remix procedure for lime subgrade for the roadways within this project. The contractor will rehydrate and remix these sections later this week.

**Water Distribution Division:** Repairs were made on the 4200 block of King, the 1800 block of O'Neal, the 1200 block of Pollard, and the 2300 block of Church. Taps were made on the 1700 block of Sayle, the 3800 block of College, and the 3200 block of Henderson. A new water main was laid on the 3200 block of Bourland with new taps.

**Streets, Traffic, and Drainage Divisions:** Crews have fueled all equipment and have started to spread sand on icy patches in the city. Crews continue to pick up brush and work on-site with brush burn piles. Intake of resident brush ends this week. We will start burning the brush as soon as the Fire Department gives the okay.
