Public Works

Wastewater Collections Division: Crews installed roughly 110' of new sewer main and services on the 3300 block of King Street.

Engineering Division:

Stanford Street - The contractor continued to place sanitary sewer and storm pipe from Sayle to Roberts.

Sayle Street - The contractor is currently placing 250 yards of concrete from Memphis to Canton on the southbound lane.

Roy Warren Parkway - The contractor continued work on this project, and the concrete has all been placed. The roadway is expected to open around the week of March 14.

Delano Estates - The contractor completed the remix procedure for lime subgrade for roadways within this project and estimated to start concrete placement on March 9.

Carol Drive - All subgrade stabilization is complete, and testing procedures have passed. Asphalt placement started on Thursday, March 3, and should be completed this weekend.

Water Distribution Division: Crews completed work orders on the 1100 block of Wolfe City Drive, the 1800 block of O'Neal, the 700 block of Erica Circle, the 800 block of Sahara, the 5900 block of I-30, and the 5600 block of Kayway.

Streets Division: Street crews are patching potholes in numerous areas this week.

Drainage Division: Crews continued to pick up brush and work on site for brush piles.

Traffic Division: Crews are replacing new stop signs in several areas throughout the City.
