Greenville Fire-Rescue

GFR held Chiefs Interviews this week for the two open entry level firefighter positions. Should the two interviewees pass this final round, they will be in the line for becoming our next Greenville firefighters! Good luck to these candidates!

Public Works

Wastewater Collections Division: Crews repaired city-side clean-outs on the 3100 block of Mitchell Street and the 1100 block of Wolverine. Crews also installed a new city-side clean-out on the 4300 block of Lee Street.

Engineering Division:

Stanford Street Phase One - The contractor has completed all wet utilities and is in the progress of subgrade prep for the roadway.

Stanford Street Phase Two - The contractor has started to place the waterline from Moulton to Gee Street. The Traffic Control Plan will be set from Stonewall to Moulton at the beginning of next week.

Delano Estates - The contractor is placing concrete streets this week (Pic. 1). Due to rain this week, the contractor will replace and repair the section on Oliver next week.

Spencer Street - The contractor has started to move equipment on-site and will begin milling operations on Monday, April 11.

Carol Drive - The contractor has finished the roadway and storm line installations and will continue to clean and replace driveway sections on the south side of this project.

Traders Road - The contractor is continuing to replace concrete panels on the roadway. This work will continue with the eastbound lane for the next three weeks. The westbound lane will start after the eastbound lane is completed.

Water Distribution Division: Crews worked on installing a water service on the 2900 block of Texas Street. They also repaired a water main leak on the 1200 block of Wolfe City Drive.

Streets Division: Crews have removed rock piles from the Airport. Crews also completed the burn pile for winter storm debris, completed the Rees Street demo for substandard, and repaired several potholes in various areas.

Traffic Division: Crews added three new signs on Spencer Street, replaced eight stop signs at different locations in the city, and started working on chevrons in several locations.

Our Saturday Matinee for patrons 18+ will start at 1:00 p.m. on April 9.

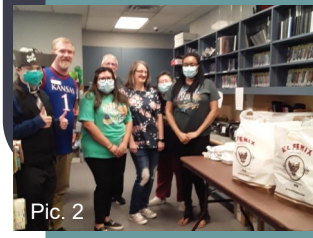
Our next Teen and Tween night is on Tuesday, April 12, starting at 5:00 p.m. Join us as we present some basics of doing family history research!
