The City of Greenville and the Greenville Police Department are looking for individuals interested in hosting neighborhood gatherings for National Night Out - Texas. National Night Out is an annual community-building campaign that promotes police-community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie to make neighborhoods safer and more caring places to live. Millions of neighbors take part in National Night Out across thousands of communities from all fifty states, U.S. territories, and military bases worldwide on the first Tuesday in August (Texas and select areas celebrate on the first Tuesday in October). In Texas, National Night Out also kicks off National Crime Prevention Month.

Neighborhoods host block parties, cookouts, and visits from emergency personnel. In Greenville, we have seen everything from potluck dinners and cookouts to bounce houses and carnival games, and there has even been a live band at one neighborhood party. Police officers, firefighters, paramedics, and city officials spend the evening going to as many locations as possible. They are there to answer questions, have fun with the kids, and eat some food and desserts.

**Wastewater Collections Division:** Crews tied in the new sewer line on Sayle Street. They are still waiting for the bacterial results from the Cedar Street water main installation.

### Engineering Division:

**Stanford Street West** - Currently, the contractor is replacing sanitary sewer lines and storm sewer on the east section of this project. On the west side of this project, the contractor is paving to Stonewall Street. It is estimated that paving will be completed within the next two weeks.

**Washington Street** - Paving on Washington Street is currently at Rainey and is moving east to College Street. All utilities have been replaced, and the contractor is cleaning the project areas.

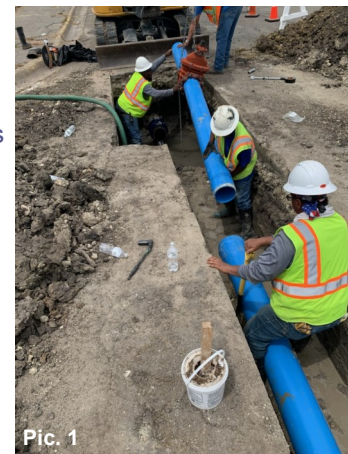
**Walnut Street** - The contractor will start milling operations on August 18, 2022, and will continue until August 30, 2022. The contractor will also begin replacing sanitary sewer lines on the southern portion of this project.

**Water Distribution Division:** Crews worked on a water leak at the 1400 block of Skyline and the 3600 block of Texas.

**Streets/Drainage Division:** Crews are working on mowing and clean-up for Town Creek, Aerobic area, and Monty Stratton areas.

**Traffic Division:** Crews have made and installed 15 street signs on Blades Street.

**Utility Construction Division:** Crews completed the new water tie to Texas Street. Plans are to complete the water main installation next week (Pic. 1).
