- The Planning and Zoning Commission is a nine-member board appointed by the City Council and given the responsibility to study and make recommendations on the orderly growth of Greenville. One of the commission's primary responsibilities is to assist with the development and implementation of the Comprehensive Plan.
- The Comprehensive Plan is a long-range development guide intended to direct the physical growth of the City for a 20 to 30 year period. The plan includes policies relative to the development of various physical elements in the community such as transportation, housing, recreation, and public facilities. The "Future Land Use" portion of the plan guides the Commission as they consider requests to change the zoning district.
